18th October 1985

WBro Jack C Anderson was Installed as Master by WBro E A Pullen his predecessor. The working tools were presented to the Master by WBros J G Joyce, R W Byrne and P S Mugford respectively. The address to the Master was given by WBro E Pullen, to the Wardens by WBro A Mc Donald and to the Brethren by VWBro P A Toler. A notice was received announcing the First Festival to be held by the Grand Charity and the creation of the Lodge Relief Chest scheme.

A letter from the Masonic Hall Management advised a 1/3 increase in dining fees and a further increase in room charges. As it was impossible for the current dues to cover these increases a notice of motion was give that the lodge should in future meet four times a year instead of five. The minutes of this meeting were countersigned by the RW Prov G Master who attended the next meeting.

15th November 1985

This meeting was to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Consecration of the Lodge. After the Lodge was opened the Master invited WBro E V Bowers a Founder of the Lodge to occupy the Chair.

The Prov GDC announced the arrival of the Prov G Master RW Bro Rt Hon Lord Shannon, the Dep Prov G Master VWBro P A Toler, Asst Prov G Master WBro LGT Rice and the Prov G Chap WBro Rev P Hemingway. A procession was duly formed and the Prov G Master and party entered the Lodge. The Prov G Master was saluted and offered the Gavel which he accepted and then addressed the Lodge wishing it well for the future. WBro Bowers resumed the Chair.

The minutes of the Consecration Meeting on 18 October 1935 were read. W Bro A McDonald one of the first Initiates gave an address on the history of the first fifty years of the Lodge. An oration was given by the Prov GChap. Cheques totalling £900 for the Prov G Masters Fund and the four main Masonic Charities were handed to the Prov G Master.

The proposition to reduce the number of meetings to four per year was duly agreed. A paper from the Royal Masonic Hospital was read in which members were asked to vote as to whether they were in favour of the hospital closing. A proposition was duly made by WBro R Hobern and seconded by VW Bro P Toler that the Lodge agree to the closure. This was carried on a show of hands. An application form for Initiation was read from Mr Alan Richard Morgan. Twenty eight members two Honorary members and Seventy seven guests attended the meeting

17th January 1986

A Proposal Form for Initiation in the name of Mr Alan Richard Morgan was read and a ballot held which proved in his favour. Mr Morgan was then admitted to the Lodge and Initiated by the Master. The working tools were presented by Bro P Mugford and the charge given by WBro F B Barnes. WBro E Randall the Treasurer presented the accounts which were approved by the members. The Secretary announced that letters

of thanks had been received from the various charities to which gifts had been given at the 50th Anniversary Meeting and from a number of the guests.

21st March 1986

Bro A R Morgan was Passed to the Second Degree by the Master who also gave a long rendition of the working tools. WBro K Dicker gave an explanation of the Tracing Board. Ballots were held for Master, Treasurer and Tyler which proved in favour of WBros R Goodall, E Randall and C J Gossington respectively.

A letter from the Chairman of the Surrey Masonic Halls Fund was read with a copy of a letter from the Provincial Grand Master establishing the Fund in which all Lodges were asked to subscribe annually the sum of £2 per member to the Fund. An application form for Initiation from Mr Eric John Kirkland was read.

17th October 1986

After the Lodge was opened the brethren stood to order as WBro P Churchod spoke of the work of WBro S Bowers PPSGD who died 18 May 1986. Bro Bowers was the brother of WBro E Bowers a founder of the Lodge. A successful ballot was held for a candidate for initiation, Mr E J Kirkland. The Lodge approved payments of £30 each to WBros. E Randall PPJGD, and E Pullen PPAGDC towards the purchase of their Provincial Grand Rank regalia and the same to WBro R Goodall PPSGW to get his regalia modified.

The Master then Installed WBro Goodall. WBro J Anderson gave the address to the Master, WBro J Shepherd to the Wardens and WBro A McDonald to the Brethren. An application for Initiation was read from Dr Tudor Ewart Thomas

21st November 1986

VWBro PA Toler Dep Prov GM attended with WBro. LGT Rice Asst Prov GM. and WBro B Bevan Prov G Sec. The death of WBro V H Bray PPAGSwdB was reported and the brethren stood to order as a mark of respect.

WBro E Pullen was invited to take the Masters Chair and Raise Bro A R Morgan. The Traditional History was given by the Master.

A Proposal Form for Initiation from Dr T E Thomas was read and a successful ballot held. Bro R H Williams the Almoner asked the Lodge to support a Petition to the RMBI on behalf of Mrs W E Bache. This was approved by the members.

The Secretary reported receipt of a letter from the Grand Secretary regarding the Royal Masonic Hospital and the statement directed by the High Court as to the conduct to be followed for election to the Board of Management. The Lodge voted in favour of the candidates of WBro Douglas Brookes.

16th January 1987

WBro R Hobern who was absent from the Installation Meeting was invested as Senior Warden by the Master. The Treasurer presented the Accounts for the year ended 30 September 1986. WBro J C Anderson one of the auditors proposed their adoption this was seconded by W Bro F B Barnes and approved by the members. The two candidates for Initiation named on the summons were not present.

20th March 1987

The Master reported the death of WBro E Ansell PPJGW a former member and Honorary member and WBro G S A Joyce PPAGDC. The brethren stood to order as a mark of respect. Dr T E Tomas was Initiated by the Master who also presented the working tools and gave the Charge. VW Bro PA Toler was elected Master for the ensuing year, WBro E Randall Treasurer and WBro Gossington Tyler. The resignation of WBro LGT Rice PSGD as Asst PGM was announced. His place had been filled by WBroT Doyle PAGDC. WBro E V Bowers paid tribute to the Master for all the work he had undertaken over the years for the Lodge as Secretary and twice Master and on behalf of the members handed to Bro Goodall a cheque from the members as a sign their appreciation.

16th October 1987

The Master reported the death of Bro W K Howarth. The brethren stood to order as a mark of respect. The Master invited WBro K Southern to act as S W, WBro E Randall, J W and WBro I Maslyn, IG. The D C presented VWBro P A Toler Master Elect who re-affirmed his obligation and was duly Installed as Master by WBro Goodall who then presented the working tools and gave the address to the Master. The address to the Wardens was give by WBro J Shepherd and to the Brethren by WBro W McDonald.

The Lodge was called off to receive a presentation by WBro C Dunn ProvSGW and WBro M D Slack on behalf of 1997 RMBI Festival Committee.

The Lodge was called on and the Secretary read a letter from WBro E Bowers regarding the Memorial Service for WBro E Ansell PPJGW who had bequeathed his body for medical science. Notice of motion was given to meet on the third Friday in May instead of the third Friday in November. An application for Initiation was read from Mr David Thomas. A letter was received from the RMBI advising the death of Mrs Winifred Preston, the wife of the Founding Secretary of the Lodge.

20th November 1987

WBro W Burrows absent from the Installation meeting was invested as Junior Warden. Bro T E Thomas was passed to the second degree by the Master who also explained the working tools. WBro E Pullen presented the Tracing Board. A successful ballot was held for Mr David Thomas a candidate for Initiation. In accordance with the notice of motion given at the previous meeting the Lodge agreed to change the November meeting date to May.

15th January 1988

Mr David Thomas was Initiated by the Master, the Working Tools presented by WBro E Glendenning and the Charge given by WBro J Shepherd. The accounts for the year ended 30 September 1987 were presented and approved by the members.

18th March 1988

The Master invited WBro R Goodall to occupy the Master's chair and Raise Bro T E Thomas. WBro E Pullen gave the Traditional History and presented the Working Tools. WBro J G Joyce was elected Master for the ensuing year, WBro E Randall

Treasurer and WBro C Gossington Tyler. A motion to increase the subscription to £58 for a full member and £25 for a non-dining member was approved.

A letter from the Province announced the appointment of WBro A R Tysoe, PAGESuptWks as an Asst Prov G Master. It was agreed to donate £30 to WBro E J Smith to help defray the cost of his clothing on his being appointed PPGStB.

21st October 1988

WBro J Shepherd spoke of the death of Bro J Rollason and his continual fight against polio from boyhood. The Brethren stood as a mark of respect. The Master presented a Grand Lodge Certificate to Bro T E Thomas. The Master invited WBro R Phillips to act as SW, WBro R L Goodall, JW and WBro I Maslyn, IG. WBro J G Joyce Master Elect was presented affirmed his obligation and was Installed as Master. The Working Tools were presented by WBros E Pullen, I Maslyn and J Anderson. The addresses to the Master, Wardens and Brethren were given by VW Bro P Toler, WBro J Shepherd and WBro B Bevan.

20th January 1989

Two Brethren who missed the installation meeting WBro E Randall and Bro W D Howson were invested as Treasurer and Steward respectively. The Lodge was opened in the Second Degree and WBro J C Anderson was invited to occupy the Master's Chair and Pass Bro D Thomas to the Second Degree. Bro T E Thomas presented the working tools and WBro F Barnes the Tracing Board. The audited accounts were presented and approved by the members. Donations were approved to the RMBI, MIGB and the RMH Samaritan Fund.

17th March 1989

The Master invited WBro E Pullen to occupy the Master's Chair and Raise Bro D Thomas to the Third Degree. WBro R Goodall gave the Traditional History and Bro T. Thomas presented the working tools. A notice to raise the subscription to £63 for full members and £29m for non-dining members was approved. VW Bro P A Toler proposed that the sum of £40 be donated toward the cost of clothing for WBro W C Burrows on his appointment to PPJGD

19th May 1989

VWBro P A Toler presented a Grand Lodge Certificate to Bro D Thomas. WBro G J C Hambling presented a paper entitled "The unusual entry of HM Habibullah Khan, the Amir of Afghanistan into Freemasonry in Calcutta in 1907". WBro W Burrows was elected master, for the ensuing year WBro E Randall, Treasurer and WBro C Gossington, Tyler. An application to join was read from Bro Harold J Day.

20th October 1989

A successful ballot was held for a joining member Bro Harold J Day . The Master invited WBro J Anderson to act as SW, WBro R Goodall, JW and WBro R Hobern, IG. The Master Elect WBro W Burrows was presented, reaffirmed his obligation and was duly Installed. The Working Tools were presented by WBro J Joyce, Bro T Thomas and Bro E Smith respectively. The addresses to the Master, Wardens and

Brethren were given by WBro J Joyce, WBro J Shepherd and VWBro P A Toler. An application for membership was read from Mr G K F Scott.

19th January 1990

Bro R Byrne who was absent from the installation meeting was invested as SW. The Master welcomed Bro H J Day a joining member. A successful ballot was held to initiate Mr. G K F Scott. The Master invited WBro R Goodall to occupy the Masters Chair and initiate Mr Scott. Bro Goodall also presented the Working Tools and gave the Charge. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 1989 were presented and approved by the members. A letter was read from the family of WBro T A Crisp reporting his death.

16th March 1990

W Bro R Goodall spoke of the late WBro T A Crisp and the Brethren stood in his memory. The Master Passed Bro G Scott to the Second Degree and presented the Working Tools. WBro F Barnes gave an explanation of the Second Degree Tracing Board. Pursuant to notice it was agreed that the subscription be raised to £69 for full members and to £31 for non-dining members. A letter from the Province reported that WBro Rev N Barker-Cryer had resigned as an Asst Prov GM and that W Bro K G Twitchen PAGDC had been appointed in his place.

18th May 1990

W Bro R L Goodall spoke of the late WBro E V Bowers, MBE PPSGW a Founder of the Lodge who had recently died. The Brethren stood to order as a mark of respect. The Master invited WBro E Pullen to occupy the Masters Chair and Raise Bro G Scott. Bro A Morgan presented the Working Tools. The ballot for Master for the ensuing year was in favour of Bro R Byrne. W Bro E Randell was re-elected Treasurer and WBro C Gossington Tyler. It was proposed that the sum of £40 be donated to WBro J B F Shepherd to help defray the cost of clothing on his promotion to PPSGD and the same sum to WBro F B Barnes on his promotion to PPJGD.

19th October 1990

In the absence of the Master WBro J Anderson presided. VWBro P Toler presented a Grand Lodge Certificate to Bro G Scott. The Master requested WBro R Goodall to occupy the Senior Wardens Chair, WBro E Smith to continue as Junior Warden and WBro E Randall to act as Inner Guard. The Master Elect Bro R W Byrne was presented and after confirming his acceptance of the Ancient Principles and Tenets affirmed his obligation and was Installed as Master. The Working Tools were presented by Bros A Morgan, T E Thomas and D Thomas. The addresses were given by WBros J Anderson, J Shepherd and VWBro P A Toler.

18th January 1991

WBro B Hobern who was absent from the Installation meeting was invested as Almoner. The Lodge Accounts for the year ended 30th September 1990 were presented and approved by the members. The Secretary gave a report on the proceedings of the Lodge Committee. VWBro Toler suggested details of the report

should be forwarded to the Prov G Secretary. VWBro Toler presented a paper entitled "The Letter G". In view of the losses incurred by brethren ceasing membership under Rule 148 Bof C (ie after 2years arrears) WBro Anderson proposed that the Lodge Bylaws be amended to permit Exclusion under Rule 181 B of C before the second years subscription becomes due. This was approved by the members.

15th March 1991

Pursuant to Notice increases in subscriptions were duly approved, £90 for full members, £40 for non-dining members. Pursuant to another notice £40 was donated to the Prov G Masters Charity Fund and £14 to the Tyler to ensure the availability of Lodge furniture and tools not supplied by the Masonic Hall. WBro F Barnes presented a paper "A viewpoint of the Mysteries of the Kabbalah and Freemasonry" A letter from the Prov G Sec reported the retirement of WBro A R Tysoe as an Asst Prov GM and the appointment of WBro J B Toler PAGDC in his place.

17th May 1991

A ballot for master was in favour of Bro H J Day. The Treasurer WBro E Randell and Tyler, W Bro C Gossington were re-elected. It was proposed and agreed that the sum of £40 each be donated to W Bro J B Toler to defray the cost of clothing on his appointment to Asst Prov GM, to WBro J S C Anderson on his appointment to Prov JGD, and to WBro K J Southern on his promotion to PPJGD.

18th October 1991

The Master requested WBro J C Anderson to occupy the Masters Chair, WBro W C Burrows the Senior Wardens and W Bros E J Smith and K J Southern to continue as Junior Warden and Inner Guard respectively. The Master Elect Bro H J Day was presented, confirmed his acceptance of the Antient Principles and Tenets of the Craft was obligated and Installed as Master. The working tools of the three degrees were presented by WBro J Anderson, Bro T E Thomas and WBro E Smith. The three Addresses were given by WBros J Anderson, J Shepherd and R Goodall. An application for Initiation was read from Mr Raymond Welsh.

17th January 1992

VWBro PA Toler PGSwdB Dep Prov G Master, WBro H M Sharp PSGD Asst Prov G Master and WBro B Bevan PJGD Prov G Sec made an official visit to the Lodge. The Master reported the death of WBro A C McDonald PGStB, Bro Goodall spoke of the work he had done for the Lodge. The Brethren stood to order as a mark of respect. A successful ballot was held for Mr Raymond Welsh who was admitted and Initiated by the Master. The Working Tools were presented by WBro J Anderson and the charge given by WBro R Goodall. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 1991 were approved by the members. WBro Shepherd suggested the Lodge consider getting a plaque showing the Lodge jewel which could be placed with those of other Lodges in the Hall Lounge.

20th March 1992

In the absence of the Master WBro W Burrows presided. The death of WBro F Barnes was reported and Bro Goodall spoke of his membership of the lodge. The Brethren stood to order as a mark of respect. WBro Burrows invited WBro Sharp Asst Prov GM to occupy the Masters Chair for the purpose of Passing Bro R Welsh to the Second Degree. The Tracing Board was presented by WBro E Pullen. The Master appointed WBro R Goodall Secretary in place of WBro Barnes.

15th May 1992

Bro R Welsh was Raised by the Master. The Traditional History and the working tools were presented by WBro R Goodall. WBro J Shepherd was elected Master for the ensuing year WBro E Randall and WBro Gossington were re-elected Treasurer and Tyler respectively. It was agreed that the sum of £40 be given to W Bro J C Anderson to help defray the cost of clothing on his appointment to Prov DepGDC.

16th October 1992

The Asst Prov G Master WBro J B Toler PJGD paid an official visit to the Lodge. The Master asked WBro T Thompsett to occupy the Senior Wardens Chair, W Bro E J Smith the Junior Wardens and W Bro K J Southern to act as inner Guard. The Master elect WBro J Shepherd was presented, reaffirmed his obligation and was Installed by WBro H Day who also presented the working tools. The addresses were given by WBros H Day, J Anderson and I Moslyn. WBro Anderson presented a Grand Lodge Certificate to Bro R Welsh.

15th January 1993

WBro W Burrows who was absent from the Installation Meeting was invested as Chaplain and Almoner. WBro J Anderson gave a talk on the Grand lodge Certificate and explained various points in the form of a question and answer session. An application for Joining membership was read from WBro R D B White PPSGW and for Initiation from Mr B J H Lindfield.

19th March 1993

WBro E Randall who was absent from the Installation Meeting was invested as Treasurer. Ballots were held to elect WBro R D B White a joining member and Mr B J H Lindfield, both were successful. Pursuant to a Notice of Motion it was agreed to raise the Full Subscription to £95 and the Non-Dining subscription to £45. Mr Lindfield was admitted and Initiated by the Master, the Working Tools presented by WBro E E Randall and the Charge given by WBro R D B White.

21st May 1993

In the absence of the Master WBro J Anderson presided and Passed Bro B Lindfield to the Second Degree and presented the Working Tools. WBro R A Barton explained the Tracing Board. The ballot for Master was in favour of Bro T E Thomas, W Bro Randall for Treasurer and WBro Gossington, Tyler.

15th October 1993

The Master asked WBro WC Burrows to occupy the Senior Wardens Chair, WBro E Smith the Junior Wardens and WBro K J Southern to act as Inner Guard. The Master Elect Bro T W Thomas was presented and after confirming his acceptance of the Antient Principles and Tenets was installed as Master. The Working Tools were presented by WBros R Barton, I Moslyn and J B F Shepherd. The addresses were given by WBros R White, J B F Shepherd and VWBro P A Toler.

21st January 1994

The Brethren stood to order as a mark of respect for Bro J W Mounsey who died on 7th November 1993. Three officers absent from the Installation meeting were invested with their collars. WBro J Anderson assumed the Masters Chair and raised Bro B J H Lindfield to the Third Degree. WBro R Goodall gave the Historical Lecture and presented the working tools. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 1993 were presented and accepted. An application for Initiation was read from Mr M C A Kawoya

18th March 1994

A successful ballot having been held Mr M C A Kawoya was Initiated by the Master. The working tools were presented by WBro R Byrne and the charge given by WBro R White. It was agreed that the Lodge Charity Association should close and the funds be transferred to a Relief Chest. A Grand Lodge Certificate was presented to Bro B J H Lindfield by WBro J C Anderson. A letter from the Province reported that WBros J B Toler and O G R Tomlin were retiring as Asst Prov G Masters and their places were to be filled by WBros B Bevan and LtCol D A M Phipps. A Proposal form for joining membership was read in the name of WBro B F Steggles and an application for Initiation from Mr A C G Croci.

20th May 1994

Successful ballots were held for WBro B F Steggles to Join and Mr A C G Croci for Initiation. The Lodge agreed to donate £40 to WBro E Randall to help defray the cost of regalia on his promotion to PPGReg. Mr Croci was Initiated by the Master, the working tools were presented by WBro R Byrne and the charge given by WBro R White. WBro R White was elected Master for the ensuing year. WBro E Randall was re-elect Treasurer and WBro C Gossington, Tyler. An application for joining was read from WBro R T P Heppel.

21st October 1994

A successful ballot was held to elect WBro R T P Heppel a joining member. The Master asked WBro W Burrows to occupy the Senior Wardens Chair, WBro I Moslyn the Junior Wardens and WBro K Southern to act as Inner Guard. The Master elect W Bro R White was presented, reaffirmed his obligation and was duly Installed as Master. The Working Tools were presented by WBro I Moslyn, Bro D Thomas and W Bro RW Byrne. The addresses were given by WBros R Goodall, J Shepherd and WBro J Anderson. It was agreed to donate £700 to the 1997 R M B I list. The new Prov G Sec WBro P W Waight, PAGDC was welcomed.

20th January 1995

WBro E Randall and WBro E Smith who were absent from the Installation meeting were invested as Treasurer and Junior Deacon respectively. Bro M C A Kawoya was Passed to the Second Degree by the Master who also presented the Working Tools and the Tracing Board. W Bro H Sharpe PSGD Asst Prov G Master, gave a talk regarding the the New Masonic Samaritan Fund. The Lodge accounts for the year ended 30th September 1994 were presented and approved. An application for Joining membership was read for Bro D M Bole.

17th March 1995

The Asst Prov G Master WBro W M Sharp PSGD attended the meeting accompanied by the Prov G Sec WBro P W Waight PAGDC. A successful ballot was held to admit Bro D Bole a member. Bro M Kayowa was Raised to the Third Degree by the Master who also gave the Traditional History and presented the Working Tools. WBro J Anderson then Passed Bro A Croci to the Second Degree. It was agreed that the subscription be raised to £100 for a full member and to £50 for a non-dining member.

19th May 1995

Bro A Croci was Raised to the Third Degree by the Master who gave the Traditional History and presented the Working Tools. Bro D Thomas was elected Master for the ensuing year WBro E Randall re-elected Treasurer and WBro V Sedgley Tyler.

20th October 1995

Bro Croci was presented with his Grand Lodge Certificate. The Master asked WBro E Smith to occupy the Senior Wardens Chair. Bro D Thomas Master Elect was presented affirmed his obligation and was Installed as Master by WBro R White who also presented the working tools of the three Degrees. The addresses were given by WBros White, J Shepherd and VWBro P Toler.

19th January 1996

The Brethren absent from the Installation meeting WBros R Byrne Senior Warden T Thomas Chaplain and E Randall Treasurer were invested by the Master. WBro J Anderson gave a full explanation of the Grand Lodge Certificate which was presented to Bro Croci at the last meeting and WBro R D B White followed with an explanation of the Second Degree Tracing Board. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 1995 were presented and approved. The Province advised that WBros K Twitchen and J L Mason had retired as Asst Prov G Masters and had been replaced by WBros H A Davis and J G Willson.

15th March 1996

WBro R A Crane gave a talk "Some thoughts on the Royal Arch in particular and Freemasonry in general".

17th May 1996

The 4th and 7th sections of the 1st Lecture were given by WBro G Channon, Bro M Woods and WBro R L Monday. The ballot for Master for the ensuing year was in

favour of W Bro R W Byrne, W Bro E E Randall was re-elected Treasurer and W Bro V Sedgley Tyler. An application to join was read from Bro H G Beck.

18th October 1996

The Master reported the deaths of WBros P Churchod and R Heppel. W Bro R L Goodall and J C Anderson spoke of their long association with both Brethren. The Brethren stood to Order as a mark of respect. V W Bro P A Toler was invited to occupy the Masters Chair and in doing so spoke of the service given to the lodge by W Bro R L Goodall during his 58 years membership and presented to him various gifts to mark the occasion. A ballot was successfully held to elect Bro H G Beck a joining member. W Bro W C Burrows was requested to occupy the Senior Wardens chair and W Bro E J Smith the Junior Wardens. W Bro R J Twyman acted as Inner Guard. W Bro R W Byrne Master Elect was presented, re-affirmed his obligation and was installed as Master. The Working Tools were presented by W Bro R White, Bro R Walsh and M Kawoya respectively. The addresses were given by WBros R White, J Shepherd and V W Bro P Toler. 19th January 2001

WBro LtCol D A M Phipps PSGD Asst Prov G Master on an official visit entered the Lodge was offered the gavel and saluted. After the signing of the minutes the Master resumed the chair. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 2000 were presented and approved. The Secretary proposed that any member whose subscription remained unpaid for five months be liable to exclusion under R181 B of C. This was agreed. Pursuant to a notice of motion WBro T Thomas proposed that the sum of £1000 be donated to the Prov G Masters Millenium appeal, this was approved. The candidate due for Initiation was not present so a demonstration of the degree was given. RWBro Toler spoke of the Masonic Classic Car rally to be held on 30 June as part of 'Freemasonry in the Community week' in which he would be driving his 1903 Cadillac and invited Brethren to sponsor him, the proceeds of the rally going to the Whizz-Kids Charity, the movement for non-mobile children.

6th September 2002

WBro R Twyman Master Elect being unable to proceed an Emergency Meeting by dispensation was called and Bro A Croci was elected Master for the ensuing Year.

18th October 2002

The Master announced the sad death of WBro R Twyman, the Brethren stood in his memory. Bro A Croci Master Elect was presented obligated and Installed as Master

by WBro R White. The addresses to the Master, Wardens and Brethren were given by WBros R White, J Shepherd and RWBro P Toler.

17th January 2003

WBro A R Perry PAGDC was welcomed by the Master as the Official Provincial Representative. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 2002 were presented and approved. The candidate for Raising was unable to attend but a demonstration was given instead with the help of two visitors from Letchworth Lodge.

21st March 2003

Bro C J Lafferty who was unable to attend the previous meeting was Raised to the Third degree by the Master, W Bro J Anderson gave the Traditional History and presented the Working Tools.

16th May 2003

A discussion was held concerning the future of the Lodge. The Master stated that a lack of candidates for Initiation and Joining over the past years had left the Lodge in a serious position. WBro Anderson agreed with the Master and also pointed out that a number of candidates had failed to last the course which reflected in a general lack of commitment to learning the ritual and attendance at the L of I. RWBro P Toler reminded the members that his father, and uncles had been involved with the Lodge from its start and that he and his brother were both initiated in the Lodge. He did however, feel that the Lodge had come to the end of its viable life and gave Notice of Motion that the Warrant be surrendered. Further observations by brethren referred to the lack of Social occasions and White Table meetings which could attract members. It was also pointed out that many young men found it difficult to get away from business in time for a 5.00PM start. A further notice of motion was made as to the disposal of the Lodge assets should it be decided to return the Warrant. WBro A Croci was re-elected Master, WBro M Kawoya Treasurer and W Bro J Lyons Tyler.

17th October 2003

WBro A R Perry PAGDC the official visitor was welcomed. The death of WBro Paul Steiner was reported and the Brethren stood to order in respect. A Grand Lodge Certificate was presented to Bro C Lafferty by WBro R White. A ballot was held to return the Lodge Warrant but this was rejected. Subject to the outcome of the proposition to hand in the warrant a further ballot was held for Master for the ensuing year which proved in favour of WBro D Bole. The installation to be held by dispensation in November.

8th November 2003

A dispensation to hold an Emergency Meeting was read. WBro D Bole Master Elect was duly presented re affirmed his obligation and was installed as Master of the Lodge. Addresses to the Master and Brethren were given by WBro R White and RWBro P Toler respectively.

16th January 2004

Three Officers not present at the Installation Meeting were invested. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 2003 were approved. A letter from the Prov G Sec announced the retirement of WBro G Churchill-Coleman as an Asst Prov G M and that WBro C Rashbrook had been appointed in his place. An application for joining membership was read from Bro A G Howard-Harwood. Following the meeting the Brethren remained in their regalia and were joined by their non-Masonic guests. WBro K Waters gave a talk entitled ‘Masonry-past present and future’ The members and their guest dined together.

21st May 2004

A successful ballot was held to elect Bro A G Howard-Harwood a joining member. A demonstration of a Second Degree ceremony was given with WBro D Wright as Master. WBro D Bole presented the working tools and WBro S Sayer explained the Tracing Board. WBro D Bole was re-elected Master for the ensuing year WBro M Kawoya Treasurer and WBro J Lyons Tyler

15th October 2004

WBro R D B White PJGD was elected an Honorary Member of the Lodge. WBro D Bole having been re-elected Master was proclaimed as such by the Director of Ceremonies. The Master invested his officers and WBro K Waters gave the address to the Brethren.

21st January 2005

W Bro A R Perry PAGDC representing the Prov G Master was welcomed by the Master. Accounts for the year ended 30th September 2004 were presented and approved. A demonstration of the First Degree ceremony was then given. A donation of £300 was given to the Prov G Master’s appeal for the Asian earthquake disaster fund (Tsunami Appeal).

18th March 2005

A short business meeting. With reports on the health of several members and the birth of a son to Bro Jonathan Belch and his wife. A letter from the Prov G Sec announced that the Tsunami Fund appeal was now closed and that Surrey Masons had raised £100,000.

20th May 2005

WBro D Bole was presented with a set of gavels by a Lodge under the Jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of Victoria during a recent visit to Australia and was pleased to pass them on for use in Glenmore Lodge. WBro B Lindfield was proclaimed Master for the ensuing year. WBro Les Hutchinson, Secretary to the Council of the RMTGB gave a talk on the work of the Charity. As a result of a Riverside Walk on the 8th July on behalf of the RMTGB Festival Appeal the Brethren of Glenmore Lodge raised approx. £500 to which WBro Hutchinson added the sum of £1500 which he had personally raised. This enabled the Charity Steward to hand a cheque for £6639.88 to WBro Hutchinson for the appeal. A Silver Gavel was presented to Bro Hutchinson in recognition of his having raised the most sponsorship money. Bro Huchinson thanked the members for the donation and the Gavel which he said would be put on display in the Trust Office.

18th January 2008

In the absence of the Treasurer the accounts for the year ended 30th September 2007 were not yet available. Officers absent from the Installation Meeting were invested. WBro P Caeiro Prov Dep G Supt Wks gave a talk entitled 'Masonic Clothing'. The Charity Steward reminded Brethren of the Lodge Lunch on 1st June in support of the Festival.

28th March 2008

The absence of the Treasurer had unfortunately again held up the presentation of the accounts but they were being dealt with by another member and should be ready for the next meeting. A proposition to increase the subscription to £95 was approved and another to transfer £3000 from the Lodge Relief Chest to the RMTGB for the 2008 Festival. A request under Rule 173(a) to Pass Bro A S Ramshaw of the Minster Lodge No 8510 had not been received so a rehearsal was held with WBro R Garrett as Master. WBro Ford Gillespie volunteered to be the Candidate.

16th May 2008

WBro K Garrett announced that at the meeting of Provincial Grand Lodge on 27th June WBro D Bole would be promoted to PPAGDC, WBro A Croci to PPJGD and WBro M Kawoya to PPJGD. The accounts for the year ended 30th September 2007 were presented and approved. WBro D Wright was elected Master for the ensuing year, WBro K Garrett, Treasurer and WBro E Tate, Tyler. A formal application from Minster Lodge had been received to Pass Bro A S Ramshaw and as the Master of the Minster Lodge was present he was invited to occupy the Masters chair to ask the usual questions. WBro R Garrett then occupied the Masters Chair and Passed Bro Ramshaw to the Second Degree. The final figures for the 2008 Festival were

announced at the dinner on 9th May. The Province raised £3,559.366. Glenmore Lodge contributed £6850.

17th October 2008

The Master announced the death of WBro Kenneth Southern. WBro W Burrows spoke of his membership of the lodge and the Brethren stood to order in memory. The Master asked WBros K Waters, W Burrows and K Garrett to act as Senior Warden, Junior Warden and Inner Guard respectively and WBro R. Garrett to occupy the Masters Chair and install WBro D Wright the Master Elect. WBro Lindfield then conducted the remainder of the ceremony. WBro A Croci gave the address to the Master, WBro J Shepherd that to the Wardens and WBro K Waters to the Members. The Secretary reported that Bro J Turner, now in his 89th Year, had been a member of the Craft for sixty years and that he had communicated this fact to the Prov G Sec.

16th January 2009

The death of RW Bro Philip Toler PJGW was reported by the Master. WBro K Waters spoke of his membership of the Lodge and of his work for the Province as Prov GDC, Asst Prov G Master and later as Dep Prov G Master. The Brethren stood to order in memory. WBro P C Methley, PPJGW was welcomed as the official visitor by the Master. The Treasurer presented the accounts which were accepted by the members. Bro A S Ramshaw of Minster Lodge No 8510 who was Passed by request at the meeting on 16th May 2008 was raised by the Master. WBro K Waters gave the Traditional History and Bro A Coney presented the working tools. On the proposition by WBro K Waters Seconded by WBro D Bole the sum of £100 was donated to the Stroke Association in memory of RW Bro Toler. WBro Methley congratulated the Lodge on their response to the 2008 Festival Appeal for the RMTGB (£6850) and presented the Lodge with a Bronze Alms Badge. The Secretary reported receipt of an application from Bro A S Ramshaw to join the Lodge.

20th March 2009

Pursuant to a notice of motion the members agreed to raise the subscription to £100 and to transfer the sum of £330 to the Lodge Relief Chest. Bro A S Ramshaw of Minster Lodge No 8510 was elected a joining member. A First Degree rehearsal was conducted by the Master with WBro Eric Tate the Tyler acting as the Candidate, WBro F Gillespie as Inner Guard and WBro P Caero as Tyler. An explanation of the Entered Apprentice Apron was given by WBro Gillespie. The Secretary reported the appointment of a new Asst Prov G Master, WBro Roy Hawker and Prov G Sec WBro John Tomlin. The Secretary announced receipt of an application for Initiation from Mr Eduardo Lacerda.

15th May 2009

The Secretary proposed that Bro D Poole be elected the lodge Membership Officer WBro K Waters Seconded and the members confirmed the appointment.

The Secretary reported that only two candidates had been nominated for Master and Treasurer for the ensuing year, WBros D Wright and K Garrett. The Master declared that in accordance with Rules 105(a) and 112 (a) of the B of C and as no call had been made for a ballot they were duly elected to those offices.

A favourable ballot was held to Initiate Mr Eduardo Lacerda, who was admitted to the Lodge and Initiated by the Master. Bro D Poole presented the Working Tools and WBro A Croci gave the Charge.

The Almoner reported that Bro Coney and his wife were delighted to announce an addition to their family in the birth of a son 'Oscar'.

16th October 2009

The death of Bro John Turner was announced. WBro W Burrows spoke of his long association with masonry over sixty years and in particular with his membership of Glenmore Lodge since 1947. The Brethren stood to order as a mark of respect.

WBro K Waters presented a Grand Lodge Certificate to Bro A Ramshaw and the Master welcomed him to the Lodge as a joining member.

WBro D W Wright having been re-elected Master was proclaimed as such by the Director of Ceremonies. The addresses to the Wardens and Brethren were given by W Bros J Shepherd and K Waters respectively.

Bro D Poole the Membership Officer explained his position and why the Provincial Grand Master had created the post. The basic idea being to look at various ways to stimulate interest in Freemasonry for non-masonic friends which would attract them to become members.

It was reported that £100 under the name of Glenmore Lodge, part of the sum of £600 raised at the Ladies Night had been donated to the UK based Charity TOFS which supports families with children born with Tracheo-Oesophageal Fistula. It was suggested that the balance of £500 be donated to the RMBI in memory of Bro John Turner who was a resident at Prince Edward Duke of Kent Court, Essex.

On 17th March 2006 the Lodge had agreed to pay the cost of the Lof I Officers Night. The Lodge at that time was unable to meet this commitment but circumstance had changed and the Lodge could now fulfil its obligation. WBro K Waters proposed that the sum of £100 be given to the Lof I to pay these costs. WBro K Garrett seconded and the resolution was agreed.

15th January 2010

W Bro C L Rashbrook PSGD, Asst Prov GM visited the lodge accompanied by RW Bro T Doyle, PProv GM. WBros D Bole and R Welsh absent from the installation meeting were invested by the Master as DC and JD respectively. Bro E Lacerda who was due for Passing had unfortunately had to return to Brazil to be with his sick father. A demonstration of the Degree was conducted with WBro R Welsh as candidate.
